The business of the Meeting affects your shareholding and your vote is important.

Voting eligibility

The Directors have determined pursuant to Regulation 7.11.37 of the Corporations Regulations 2001 (Cth) that the persons eligible to vote at the Meeting are those who are registered Shareholders at 7.00pm (AEDT) on 3 November 2015.

Voting in person

To vote in person, attend the Meeting at the time, date and place set out above.

Voting by proxy

To vote by proxy, please complete and sign the enclosed Proxy Form and return by the time and in accordance with the instructions set out on the Proxy Form.

In accordance with section 249L of the Corporations Act, Shareholders are advised that:

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EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Explanatory Statement has been prepared to provide information which the Directors believe to be material to Shareholders in deciding whether or not to pass the Resolutions.

1. RESOLUTION 1 – RATIFICATION OF PRIOR ISSUE OF TRANCHE 1 SHARES

1.1 General

On 17 September 2015, the Company announced that it had received commitments of approximately \$0.75 million for a placement to a London based group of investors to continue to fund the definitive feasibility study (**DFS**) for the development of the high-grade Tiris Uranium Project.

The placement consists of the issue of 62,111,801 Shares at an issue price of \$0.01225 per Share together with one (1) Option (**Placement Options**) for every one (1) Share subscribed for exercisable at \$0.025 and expiring two years from date of issue (**Placement**).

The Placement is to be issued in two tranches. The first tranche of 48,660,000 Shares (**Tranche 1 Shares**) to raise \$596,085 was issued on 29 September 2015 under the Company's 15% capacity with ratification of the issue of the Tranche 1 Shares being sought under this Resolution 1.

The second tranche of 13,451,801 Shares (**Tranche 2 Shares**) to raise \$164,785 will be issued subject to the approval of Shareholders under Resolution 2 of this Notice.

In addition, Shareholder approval is being under sought under Resolution 2 for both the Tranche 1 and Tranche 2 Placement Options to be issued under the Placement.

Funds raised from the Placement will be applied to progressing the Company's Tiris Uranium Project DFS in Mauritania and for working capital purposes.

Resolution 1 seeks Shareholder ratification pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 7.4 for the issue of the Tranche 1 Shares (**Ratification**).

ASX Listing Rule 7.1 provides that a company must not, subject to specified exceptions, issue or agree to issue more equity securities during any 12 month period than that amount which represents 15% of the number of fully paid ordinary securities on issue at the commencement of that 12 month period.

ASX Listing Rule 7.4 sets out an exception to ASX Listing Rule 7.1. It provides that where a company in general meeting ratifies the previous issue of securities made pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 7.1 (and provided that the previous issue did not breach ASX Listing Rule 7.1) those securities will be deemed to have been made with shareholder approval for the purpose of ASX Listing Rule 7.1.

By ratifying the issue of the Tranche 1 Shares, the Company will retain the flexibility to issue equity securities in the future up to the 15% annual placement capacity set out in ASX Listing Rule 7.1 without the requirement to obtain prior Shareholder approval.

1.2 Technical information required by ASX Listing Rule 7.4

Pursuant to and in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 7.5, the following information is provided in relation to the Ratification:

- (a) 48,660,000 Shares were issued;
- (b) the issue price was \$0.01225 per Share;
- (c) the Shares issued were all fully paid ordinary shares in the capital of the Company issued on the same terms and conditions as the Company's existing Shares;
- (d) the Shares were issued to investor clients of WH Ireland in London. None of these subscribers are related parties of the Company; and
- (e) the funds raised from this issue will be applied to progressing the Company's Tiris Uranium Project DFS in Mauritania and for working capital purposes.

2. RESOLUTION 2 – ISSUE OF TRANCHE 2 SHARES AND TRANCHE 1 AND TRANCHE 2 PLACEMENT OPTIONS

2.1 General

As set out above, the Company announced on 17 September 2015 a capital raising of approximately \$0.75 million via a Placement of 62,111,801 Shares at an issue price of \$0.01225 per Share together with one (1) Option for every one (1) Share subscribed for to raise a total of \$760,870.

On 29 September 2015, the Company issued 48,660,000 Shares of the Placement, being the Tranche 1 Shares for which ratification is sought under Resolution 1.

Resolution 2 seeks Shareholder approval for the issue of:

- (a) up to 13,451,801 Tranche 2 Shares at an issue price of \$0.01225 per Share; and
- (b) up to 62,111,801 Placement Options, being the free attaching Tranche 1 and Tranche 2 Options issued on the basis of one (1) Option for every one (1) Share subscribed for under the Placement,

(together, the **Placement Securities**).

A summary of ASX Listing Rule 7.1 is set out in section 1.1 above.

The effect of Resolution 2 will be to allow the Company to issue the Tranche 2 Shares and Tranche 1 and Tranche 2 Placement Options pursuant to the Placement during the period of 3 months after the Meeting (or a longer period, if allowed by ASX), without using the Company's 15% annual placement capacity.

1.2 Technical information required by ASX Listing Rule 7.1

Pursuant to and in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 7.3, the following information is provided in relation to the issue of the Placement Securities:

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- (a) the maximum number of Shares to be issued is 13,451,801 and the maximum number of Options to be issued is 62,111,801;
 - (b) the Shares and Options will be issued no later than 3 months after the date of the Meeting (or such later date to the extent permitted by any ASX waiver or modification of the ASX Listing Rules) and it is intended that issue of the Shares and Options will occur on the same day;
 - (c) the issue price will be \$0.01225 per Share and nil per Option as the Options will be issued free attaching with the Shares on a one for one basis;
 - (d) the Shares and Options will be issued to investor clients of WH Ireland in London. None of these subscribers are related parties of the Company;
 - (e) the Shares issued will be fully paid ordinary shares in the capital of the Company issued on the same terms and conditions as the Company's existing Shares;
 - (f) the Options will be issued on the terms and conditions set out in Schedule 1; and
 - (g) the Company intends to use the funds raised from the issue of the Placement Securities towards progressing the Company's Tiris Uranium Project DFS in Mauritania and for working capital purposes.

3. RESOLUTION 3 – ISSUE OF ADDITIONAL PLACEMENT SECURITIES

3.1 General

As announced on 17 September 2015, the Company, in addition to the Placement of 62,111,801 Shares referred to in Resolutions 1 and 2, may seek to raise a further \$450,000, increasing the capital raising to a total of up to \$1.2 million, through the issue of 36,750,000 additional Shares at an issue price of \$0.01225 per Share together with one (1) Option for every one (1) Share subscribed for (**Additional Placement**).

Funds raised from the Additional Placement will be applied to progressing the Company's Tiris Uranium Project DFS in Mauritania and for working capital purposes.

Resolution 3 seeks Shareholder approval for the issue of:

- (a) up to 36,750,000 Shares at an issue price of \$0.01225 per Share; and
- (b) up to 36,750,000 Options, being free attaching Options issued on the basis of one (1) Option for every one (1) Share subscribed for under the Additional Placement,

(together, the **Additional Placement Securities**).

A summary of ASX Listing Rule 7.1 is set out in section 1.1 above.

The effect of Resolution 3 will be to allow the Company to issue the Additional Placement Securities pursuant to the Additional Placement during the period of 3 months after the Meeting (or a longer period, if allowed by ASX), without using the Company's 15% annual placement capacity.

3.2 Technical information required by ASX Listing Rule 7.1

A Notice of Exercise is only effective on and from the later of the date of receipt of the Notice of Exercise and the date of receipt of the payment of the Exercise Price for each Option being exercised in cleared funds (**Exercise Date**).

7. Timing of issue of Shares on exercise

Within 15 Business Days after the Exercise Date, the Company will:

- (a) allot and issue the number of Shares required under these terms and conditions in respect of the number of Options specified in the Notice of Exercise and for which cleared funds have been received by the Company;
- (b) if required, give ASX a notice that complies with section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act, or, if the Company is unable to issue such a notice, lodge with ASIC a prospectus prepared in accordance with the Corporations Act and do all such things necessary to satisfy section 708A(11) of the Corporations Act to ensure that an offer for sale of the Shares does not require disclosure to investors; and
- (c) if admitted to the official list of ASX at the time, apply for official quotation on ASX of Shares issued pursuant to the exercise of the Options.

If a notice delivered under 7(b) for any reason is not effective to ensure that an offer for sale of the Shares does not require disclosure to investors, the Company must, no later than 20 Business Days after becoming aware of such notice being ineffective, lodge with ASIC a prospectus prepared in accordance with the Corporations Act and do all such things necessary to satisfy section 708A(11) of the Corporations Act to ensure that an offer for sale of the Shares does not require disclosure to investors.

8. Shares issued on exercise

Shares issued on exercise of the Options rank equally with the then issued shares of the Company.

9. Quotation of Shares issued on exercise

If admitted to the official list of ASX at the time, application will be made by the Company to ASX for quotation of the Shares issued upon the exercise of the Options.

10. Reconstruction of capital

If at any time the issued capital of the Company is reconstructed, all rights of an Optionholder are to be changed in a manner consistent with the Corporations Act and the ASX Listing Rules at the time of the reconstruction.

11. Participation in new issues

There are no participation rights or entitlements inherent in the Options and holders will not be entitled to participate in new issues of capital offered to Shareholders during the currency of the Options without exercising the Options.

12. Change in exercise price

An Option does not confer the right to a change in Exercise Price or a change in the number of underlying securities over which the Option can be exercised.

13. Unquoted

The Company will not apply for quotation of the Options on ASX.

14. Transferability

The Options are transferable subject to any restriction or escrow arrangements imposed by ASX or under applicable Australian securities laws.

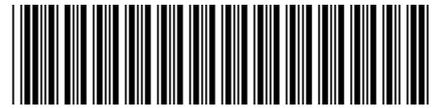
